

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## Boom, Attachments, and Upper Structure

#### **■** Boom

**Design** — Six section, formed construction of extra high tensile steel consisting of one base section and five telescoping sections. The two plate design of each section has multiple longitudinal bends for superior strength. Each telescoping section extends independently by means of one double—acting, single stage hydraulic cylinder with an integrated holding valve.

#### Boom

- 43.3-196.9 ft (13.2-60.0m) six section boom
- Four pinned positions of 0%, 46%, 93%, and 100% on each boom section provide twenty—nine extend combinations for superior capacities when varying the extension of the telescoping sections, controlled from the operator's cab.

#### **Boom Head**

- Seven 18.2 in (46.2cm) root diameter nylon sheaves to handle up to fourteen parts of line
- · Easily removable wire rope guards
- · Rope dead end lugs on one side of the boom head
- Boom head is designed for quick—reeve of the hook block

#### **Boom Elevation**

- One double acting hydraulic cylinder with integral holding valve
- Boom elevation: -1.5° to 84°
- Load Comp Load compensator maintains a consistent radius during load lift—off by automatically elevating boom hoist cylinder. Operated by a switch from the operator's cab.

- Easily removable wire rope guards

#### Swing

**Motor/Planetary** – Bi-directional hydraulic swing motor mounted to a planetary reduction unit for 360° continuous smooth swing at 1.8 rpm. Free swing capable when controller within the operator's cab is in the neutral position.

**Swing Park Brake** – 360°, electric over hydraulic, (spring applied/hydraulic released) multi-disc brake mounted on the reduction unit. Operated by a switch from the operator's cab.

**Swing Brake** – 360°, foot operated, hydraulic applied disc brake mounted to the reduction unit.

**Swing Lock** – One–position swing lock (boom over rear) operated from the operator's cab.

**Automatic Swing Brake Mode** – Swing brake applies when controller within the operator's cab is in the neutral position. Operated by a switch from the operator's cab.

**360° Positive Swing Lock – Optional** – Meets New York City requirement.

#### Central Lubrication System

Automated lubrication unit that injects grease into the turntable bearing, boom hoist cylinder pins, boom foot pin, and the main (front) and auxiliary (rear) winch. Operated by a switch from the operator's cab.

#### Electrical

Two batteries provide 24—volt operation and starting. CAN bus wiring and components, and integral self—test CSS (Control & Service System).

**Swing Alarm** – Audio warning device signals when the upper is swinging.

#### Lights

- Two working lights on front of the cab
- One rotating amber beacon on the right side of the main winch
- One boom floodlight on the boom base section
- · Two side marker lights on the boom head

## ■ Hydraulic System

#### **Main Pumps**

- Two variable displacement piston pumps for the main and auxiliary winches, boom hoist and telescope
- One fixed displacement piston pump for the counterweight removal, and swing
- One fixed displacement gear pump for pilot pressure
- One fixed displacement gear pump for telescope pinning
- The upper engine powers the pumps. Combined pump capacity of 170.7 gpm (645Lpm).
- · Remote mounted, auxiliary hydraulic oil cooler

**Pump Control "fine inching" Mode** – Special fine metering pump settings, selectable from the operator's cab, allows very slow movements to the main and auxiliary winches, boom hoist, and swing for precision work.

**Pump Control "high speed" Mode** — Boosts hydraulic oil flow by combining the two variable displacement piston pumps for the main and auxiliary winches, boom hoist up, and telescope extend. Operated by a button on the right joystick controller from the operator's cab.

**Hydraulic Reservoir** – 268 gal (1 014L) capacity equipped with sight level gauge. Diffusers built in for deaeration.

**Filtration** — One 12 micron, full flow, line filter in the control circuit. All oil is filtered prior to return to sump tank. Accessible for easy filter replacement.

**Counterbalance Valves** – All hoist motors, boom extend cylinders, and boom hoist cylinders are equipped with counterbalance valves to provide load lowering and prevents accidental load drop when hydraulic power is suddenly reduced.

**Boom Hoist Float Valves** – For transporting the boom over the rear of the crane with a boom dolly. Allows hydraulic oil within the boom hoist cylinder to flow between piston side and case side.

**Swing Brake Release Valve** – For transporting the boom over the rear of the crane with a boom dolly. Holds the 360° swing park brake in the release position allowing free rotation of the upperstructure.

#### ■ Pump Drive

All functions are hydraulically powered allowing positive, precise control with independent or simultaneous operation of all functions.

#### Fuel Tank

One 66.0 gal (250L) capacity tank.

**Integrated Third Wrap Indicator** — Rated capacity limiter color display visually and audibly warns the operator when the wire rope is on the first/bottom layer and when the wire rope is down to the last three wraps.

Auxiliary winch can be removed by cranes' counterweight removal system.


#### Counterweight

**Standard** – Total of 112,435 lb (*51 000kg*) of total counterweight consisting of auxiliary winch or 2,205 lb (*1 000kg*) counterweight and six hydraulically removable counterweights. Assembled and disassembled by hydraulic cylinders controlled from the operator's cab with capacities for:

- 0 lb (0kg) counterweight
- 28,660 lb (13 000kg) counterweight
- 55,115 lb (25 000kg) counterweight
- 81,570 lb (37 000kg) counterweight
- 112,435 lb (51 000kg) counterweight

Low speed jobsite travel is offered for these counterweight configurations and a boom dolly or boom trailer may be required for on—highway travel.

\* Overall width of the crane increases to 15 ft 1 in (4.6m) for this counterweight configuration.

#### Carrier

#### General

- 9 ft 10 in (3.0m) wide with 20.5R25 tires
- 27 ft 10 in (8.5m) wheelbase (centerline of first axle to centerline of fifth axle)
- Frame Box-type, torsion resistant, welded construction made of high tensile steel. Equipped with front and rear towing and tie-down lugs, tow connections, and access ladders.

#### Outriggers

**Boxes** – Two double box, front and rear welded to the carrier frame

**Beams and Jacks** – Four dual stage beams with Confined Area Lifting Capacities (CALC) provide selectable outrigger extensions of full and intermediate positions. Jacks with integral check valves, hydraulically controlled from the operator's cab and on both sides of carrier. Automatic leveling.

**Pontoons** – Four lightweight, stow'n go, 23.6" (60.0cm) square nylon pontoons with a contact area of 558 in<sup>2</sup> (3 600.0cm<sup>2</sup>) can be stored for road travel under the outrigger boxes.

**Main Jack Reaction** – 213,568 lb (950.0kN) force and 383 psi (2 640.7kPa) ground bearing pressure

#### Steering and Axles

 ZF—Servocom dual circuit system provides hydraulic assisted steering with a mechanical link between the steering wheel and two front axles. The two rear axles steer hydraulically and operation is based on primary and auxiliary steering modes.

**Primary Steering Mode** – Axles 4 and 5 will automatically steer in combination with axles 1 and 2 based on travel speed:

**Auxiliary Steering Modes** – Five independent modes consisting of:

- Independent Front: Axles 1 and 2 (Axle 3 is lifted)
- Combination: Axles 1, 2, 4, and 5 (Axle 3 is lifted)
- Crab: Axles 1, 2, 4, and 5 (Axle 3 is lifted)
- Independent Rear: Axles 4 and 5 (Axle 3 is lifted)
- Drive Away From Walls: Temporary crab mode (Axle 3 is lifted)

The front, combination, and crab steering modes are controlled from the steering wheel and are selected by controls in the driver's cab. Momentary switches located in the driver's cab control the rear steering mode. Limited to 3rd gear travel.

- Emergency Steering A pump is flange—mounted to the transfer box that provides hydraulic pressure to the steering circuit as long as the crane is in motion above 1.85 mph (3km/h).
- Drive Two modes: 10 x 6 for highway travel: 1st, 4th, and 5th axles are driven. 10 x 8 for job—site travel: 1st, 2nd, 4th, and 5th axle are driven.
- Axle 1 Steered, driven for job-site travel
- Axle 2 Steered, driven
- Axle 3 Non steered, non driven, lift system
- Axle 4 Steered, driven
- Axle 5 Steered, driven
- Inter-Axle Differential Lock Traction adding device that locks axles 1 and 2 with axles 4 and 5. Operated by a switch from the carrier cab.
- Transverse (Cross-Axle) Differential Locks Traction adding device that locks differentials within axles 1, 2, 4, and 5. Operated by a switch from the carrier cab with a 10 second timer.

### Suspension

Hydro-pneumatic, lockable with level adjustment and automatic ride height leveling. All axles have longitudinal and transverse trailing arms with leveling adjustment and locked cylinders. The carrier can be tilted laterally and longitudinally by controls in the carrier cab that adjust each individual suspension cylinder.

• Cylinder stroke: -4.6 in (118mm) / +6.2 in (158mm)

**Third Axle Lift System** — Axle 3 lifts independently for highway travel and job—site travel applications. Operated by a switch from the carrier cab.

**Third Axle Boost** — Axle 3 is presettable to a specific loading when the boom is over the front. Boost range is between 17,700 lb (8 028.6kg) and 30,800 lb (13 970.6kg).

### ■ Central Lubrication System

Automated lubrication unit that injects grease into the steering gear arms, steering knuckles, and suspension cylinders. Operated by a switch from the carrier's cab.

Two batteries provide 24-volt operation and starting. CAN bus wiring and components, and integral self-test CSS (Control & Service System).

#### Lights

- Front lighting includes two main headlights, two high beam lights, two fog lights, two directional indicators, and two parking lights
- Rear lighting includes two rear combination panels each with directional indicator, parking light, brake light, fog light, reversing light, and license plate light
